Subject: Cultivating Space – Women of Colour Leadership (four-day workshop)

HEU is inviting members who self-identify as Indigenous, Black, and racialized HEU women to apply to Cultivating Space: Women of Colour Leadership workshop series.

Women interested in taking on leadership roles within their union or community often face multiple barriers. In addition to gender-based discrimination, women of colour face particular barriers linked to race and their marginalization in the workplace and in society as a whole. These multiple and intersectional identities can be a barrier to participating in leadership roles.

HEU is committed to building a diverse, equitable and inclusive union. To further that work, we have designed a workshop to encourage and support women of colour within the HEU membership to take up the leadership challenge and provide the information, tools and skills necessary to succeed.

Cultivating Space – Women of Colour Leadership consists of a four day-in person workshop on April 2 - 3, 2025 and September 10 - 11, 2025. **Members who are accepted to the course are expected to attend all four days.**

This workshop will encourage members to learn and take action. Workshop topics include:

- Creating space for personal reflections, hope and sense of belonging.
- Understanding our many identities.
- Exploring our lived experience in existing power structures and learning to challenge them.
- Building our strengths, capacity, skills, solidarity, and collective power to be the creative and courageous leaders the labour movement needs.

This workshop is made up of four full-day sessions spread out over a five-month period.

Participants must be available to attend all four days from 9:00 a.m. – 4:30 p.m.
